2. MID-YEAR ASSESSMENTS (Year 1 to Year 3 Only)

The Mid-Year Assessments for Year 1 to Year 3 students will take place from **Monday, 23 May to Tuesday, 24 May.** The Mid-Year assessment schedule and topics for examination will be given to students at a later date. Please take note that students will be dismissed immediately after the last scheduled paper for the day. This allows them the time to revise and prepare for the examination. We seek your support and assistance in guiding your child / ward during this period.

3. INDUSTRY EXPERIENTIAL PROGRAMME (IEP)

All Year 4 students will be going through the IEP in Term 2. As IEP is one of the compulsory core modules leading to ITE Skills Certification (ISC), it is important that all Year 4 students complete the IEP successfully. To help them manage the IEP well, students will complete IEP either in school or at the industry. A separate note will be issued to students attached to industry.

4. PERSONALISED DIGITAL LEARNING PROGRAMME

Year 1 students who have applied for the purchase of their Personal Learning Device (PLD) will be receiving them between **Tuesday**, **12 to Thursday**, **14 April**. The PLDs will support students in the development of digital literacies and self-directed and collaborative learning. More details will be shared with you in a separate letter.

5. LAST DAY OF SCHOOL

Last day of school for Term 2 will be on Friday, 27 May. Students are to report back to school on **Monday, 27 June**.

6. MEET-THE-PARENTS SESSION

Meet-the-Parents session will be on **Friday, 1 July from 8am to 5pm**. Students <u>do not need to report</u> <u>to school</u> for lessons on that day. More information will be provided at a date closer to the event.
