2. [YEAR 4] INDUSTRY EXPERIENTIAL PROGRAMME (IEP)

4. [YEAR 1-3] MILESTONE ASSESSMENTS

The Mid-Year Assessments for Year 1 to Year 3 students will take place from **Monday, 22 May to Tuesday, 23 May**. The Milestone Assessment schedule and topics for examination will be given to students at a later date. Please take note that students will be dismissed immediately after the last scheduled paper for the day. This allows them the time to revise and prepare for the examination. We seek your support and assistance in guiding your child / ward during this period.

5. [ALL] SPORTS DAY

NLS Sports Day will be held on **Friday, 26 May** at MOE (Evans) Stadium from 8am to 1230pm. More details will be provided to students at a date closer to the event.
