#### **YEAR 1 - PERSONALISED LEARNING DEVICE**

Your child /ward will receive their learning device on Friday, 29 March, during school time. This applies to all Year 1 students whose families have already signed up to buy one. These devices will help your child/ward develop important 21<sup>st</sup> Century Competencies (21CC) they'll need for the future. To keep the devices safe and ready for use, we will store them in special charging cabinets in each classroom. Students can use them whenever their teachers plan lessons that need these devices.

When there are Home-Based Learning (HBL) days or during school holidays, students can take their devices home. This way, they can keep learning at home, while we make sure the devices are well-looked after when they're in school.

#### **YEAR 1 TO YEAR 3 MID-YEAR ASSESSMENT**

As we approach the middle of the academic year, we would like to inform you about our upcoming assessments. These assessments seek to help us understand how well your child/ward is learning. They also allow our teachers to identify areas where students might need extra help and help us improve our teaching methods.

We will soon share the schedule and topics with your child. On assessment days, students may leave school once they have completed their last paper of the day. Your support makes a big difference to your child's success. We encourage you to help them prepare well for these assessments.

#### **YEAR 4 - INDUSTRY EXPERIENTIAL PROGRAMME (IEP)**

We would like to highlight an important milestone in your child's/ward's educational journey. The Industry Experiential Programme (IEP) forms a mandatory part of their ITE Skills Certificate (ISC) requirements. Your child/ward will undertake this crucial training either at one of our industry partners' locations or through structured programmes within our school facilities.
