Please take note of the following key school events:

1. YOUTH DAY

Youth Day will be on **Sunday 2 July** in conjunction with Youth HeARTS! – An encouragement to youths to act on their aspirations and dreams to achieve their ideals and promising future. The following **Monday 3 July** will be a scheduled school holiday.

2. NLS GREAT OUTDOOR EXPERIENCE CUM DELOITTE IMPACT DAY

The annual NorthLight School Great Outdoor Experience will be held on **Friday 4 August** at the Singapore Sports Hub. All students are required to attend the school event which will be held from 7.30am to 12.30pm. Parents are welcomed to join their child/ward. More details will be made available closer to the date.

The NLS Great Outdoor Experience is an event where students are exposed to outdoor physical activities that not only requires physical and mental strength but also builds up confidence in dealing with their everyday life. It also promotes camaraderie among their peers and friends thus providing a closer bond to the school.

3. NATIONAL DAY CELEBRATIONS

Singapore's 52nd National Day will be celebrated on **Tuesday 8 August** in NorthLight School. This year's theme is a rallying call to unite all Singaporeans. "**One Nation**" is to remind Singaporeans that regardless of origin and background, we belong as one people and one nation. The day will begin with a formal commemoration of Singapore's birthday and success as a nation. This will be followed by classroom activities. Attire for the day will be the P.E. attire and **school will end at 10.30am**.

Please note that **Wednesday 9 August** is a public holiday and **Thursday 10 August** is a scheduled school holiday as part of National Day celebrations. School will resume on **Friday 11 August**.

4. SCHOOL EMERGENCY EXERCISE

Our school will be conducting an emergency exercise on **Tuesday 22 August between 09.30 am to 11.00 am**. This is an important emergency exercise that aims to train the staff and students to be prepared for any emergency in the school premises and to be familiar with the safety and evacuation procedures.

Students will experience a simulated emergency evacuation and staff will have opportunities to attend to injured casualties, traumatized students, anxious parents and even curious news reporters which are role played by our volunteers.

This emergency exercise is a collaborative effort between the School, the Ministry of Education's Security and Emergency Planning Office (SEMPO), the Singapore Civil Defence Force (SCDF) and the Singapore Police Force (SPF). Therefore, there will be fire engine, ambulance and police car entering the School. We seek your understanding should you be turned away from the School during the period of the exercise.

5. TEACHERS' DAY CELEBRATIONS

On **Wednesday 30 August** we will be celebrating Teachers' Day. School will begin at 7.45am as usual and students will be dismissed at 12.30pm on that day. The following day, **Thursday 31 August** is a school holiday. **Friday 1 September** is a public holiday (Hari Raya Haji).

* *Please note that September school break will be from **Saturday 2 September to Sunday 10 September**. Your child/ward will report to school for the new school term on **Monday 11 September**.*

6. NRIC REGISTRATION

All students born in **2002** will be eligible to register for their identity cards. The NRIC registration exercise will be held in NorthLight School on **Tuesday 18 July**.
